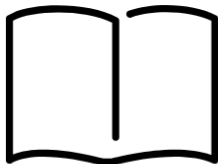


What we'll measure

Satisfaction of users receiving an intervention (including accessibility, soaking ability, size, texture, durability, appropriateness for skin, night and day use).

Qualitative research

- 1) In-depth interviews
- 2) Focus Group Discussions
- 3) Key informant interviews
